# **RECAP: 2017 Winter Fisheree & Brandan's Bash**

The details of the Pre-Battle Challenge are simple: anglers had to purchase a \$10 fishing ticket to weigh fish, and all fish registered that day were entered into a drawing where we randomly selected a winner for (1) \$1,000 Grand Prize and (1) \$500 Runner-Up prize. Payouts were also paid to anglers who had the largest fish in a variety of specie categories (see right). In addition to the fishing contest, the day was filled with raffle prizes, kid's games, food and beverages, 4x4/motorcycle and monster truck races, and more.

The weekend wouldn't be complete without the weekend's annual "kick off" event: Brandan's Bash. Friday night's bash provided entertainment from headlining band, Star Six Nine to a tent full of club supporters and party-goers. 
